

About the Author:



Political Analyst and Investigator Len Colodny published *Silent Coup: The Removal of a President*, in 1991, to immediate acclaim and controversy. He showed how Richard Nixon built his administration on secrecy, and encouraged a cadre of aides to take a series of steps that undermined his presidency. White House counsel John Dean engineered the Watergate break-in, Colodny reported, and then led the cover-up, which Nixon eagerly embraced. General Alexander Haig, a National Security Council aide and then Nixon's Chief of Staff, helped keep some of Nixon's biggest secrets and then quietly spurred the President's downfall.

Silent Coup reveals that Washington Post reporter Bob Woodward, who built his reputation on Watergate, concealed his early ties to Haig. In 1969 and 1970, then-Navy Lt. Woodward manned the Pentagon's secret communications room that managed the military's secret messages and the backchannels used by Henry Kissinger and Nixon. Woodward often delivered the details of those messages to Haig at the White House, the start of a relationship that both men went to great lengths to deny. That relationship is critical to understanding how Nixon was removed from office.

Colodny has written extensively about Nixon and Watergate. In 2009 he published a second book, *The Forty Years War*, which detailed how Nixon's presidency and his downfall was spurred by his foreign policy (Détante), and led the way to the birth of Neoconservatives in the Reagan and George W. Bush administrations, and the failed invasion of Iraq. *Forty Years War* also uncovered the Neocons geopolitical "Godfather" Frits G.A. Kraemer. Colodny lives in Florida.
